Phase I (Weeks 0-12)
─ • Weig	ghtbearing:
0	Weeks 0-2: Non-weightbearing
0	Weeks 2-4: Partial weightbearing (30-40 lbs)
	Weeks 4-6: Continue with partial weightbearing (progress to use of one crutch at weeks 6 8)
0	Weeks 6-12: Progress to full weightbearing with discontinuation of crutch use
• Brac	cing:
0	Weeks 0-2: Hinged knee brace locked in extension-remove for CPM and rehab with PT
0	 Weeks 2-4: Gradually open brace at 20° intervals as guad control is obtained
O	D/C brace when patient can perform straight leg raise without an extension lag
• Rang	ge of Motion – Continuous Passive Motion (CPM) Machine for 6 -8 hours per day for 1 month
0	Set CPM to 1 cycle per minute – set at 0-30°
0	PROM/AAROM and stretching under guidance of PT

	Weeks 0-2: Straight leg raise/Quad sets, Hamstring isometrics •• Perform exercises in the brace if quad control is inadequate
0	Weeks 2-6: Begin progressive isometric closed chain exercises** (see comments) ** At week 6 can start weight shifting activities with operative leg in extension
0	Weeks 6-10: Progress bilateral closed chain strengthening, begin open chain knee strengthening
0	Weeks 10-12: Begin closed chain exercises using resistance (less than patient's body weight), progress to unilateral closed chain exercises

— • Weig	ghtbearing: Full weightbearing with a normal gait pattern
