

COLD THERAPY UNIT INFORMATION

Do You Need this unit?

Dr. Feldman ***STRONGLY*** recommends the Cold Therapy Unit for ***ALL*** of his surgeries and requires its use for all procedures. This unit would be a tremendous asset to have as it will reduce pain and swelling significantly better and speeds up the recovery process than normal ice packs would.

WHAT IS A COLD THERAPY UNIT? – The unit has two parts:

- **The Circulating Sterile Pad** – This pad is the ONLY thing that's taken with you the day of the procedure and Dr. Feldman would place it this sterile pad in between the bandages immediately following the procedure. This pad has two tubes that are attached and will be easily accessible to plug into the unit itself.
- **The Cold Therapy Unit** – It's a mini cooler with an attached water pump built inside of it with two tubes hanging from side of unit. These tubes will plug into the two tubes that are on the circulating sterile pad. This cooler is run electronically with a wall adapter. Once its set up let it work its magic.

How do I get a Cold Therapy Unit?

They can be picked up at Dr. Feldman's office from Moe Monday – Friday (preferably Wednesdays or Fridays if possible) between the hours 9am – 4:30pm. Moe takes Lunch between 1-2pm so if possible to come around that lunch hour. It is not necessary to reserve a unit as we usually have in stock in the office. We will go over the instructions as well as give a brief demonstration of its use and function.
